Eligibility Criteria

Applicants who meet the following criteria may apply for a scholarship:

1. Be of Hawaiian ancestry
2. College-bound high school students or currently enrolled college students, enrolled full-time
3. Have a cumulative GPA of 2.5 for high school students/undergraduates and 3.3 for graduate students
4. Demonstrate academic and leadership potential

Additional Requirements

Applicants must submit the following documents along with their application:

1. Verification of Hawaiian ancestry (i.e. birth certificate, Ho'oulu Data Center letter)
2. A transcript of first semester grades
3. A resume & letter of recommendation
4. Submit an essay to the following question:  
What Hawaiian issue influenced your decision to pursue your course of study in college/university?

Current Recipients - Renewals

If you currently receive a PKHCC scholarship, please submit:

1. This application to renew your scholarship;
2. A transcript of your spring semester grades at the end of the school year.
3. A reflection statement of your community service work.

Community Service

If awarded a PKHCC scholarship, applicants are expected to embrace the PKHCC mission of community service, leadership, participation, and perpetuating the Hawaiian culture.

Scholarship recipients are expected to commit to volunteer work in their community, whether in Hawaii or away at a mainland college. Additionally, awardees are highly encouraged to participate in club activities such as helping decorate King Kamehameha Day Float decoration, assisting at scholarship fundraisers, attending monthly meetings, etc.
