2006 Convention Brief

The 47th Annual Association of Hawaiian Civic Club Convention will be hosted by the O`ahu Council & it's clubs, and will be held at the Waikiki Beach Marriott Resort & Spa in Waikiki from **October 22-29, 2006**. To make sure that it reached everyone, it was sent out by both e-mail and snail mail. It is also available on line at www.ahcc.org.

The convention committee has planned a number of interesting activities, some of which start pre-convention on October 20 and run on through to when it ends on Sunday, October 29, 2006. A block of rooms is being held at the Marriott. You may confirm your reservations directly with the hotel by using the group code HCHCCA as indicated on the form. **The Marriott room reservation deadline is September 25, 2006.**

A convention registration fee of \$40 is required for each participant. Based on our membership total of 215 members, we are entitled to one delegate and one alternate for each ten (10) members, or major fraction thereof in good standing, as shown by the per capita dues paid to AOHCC sixty (60) days prior to convention. This means that we may have as many as 40 delegates and alternatives.

PKHCC pays an annual per capita dues of \$ 4.00 to AOHCC and \$ 3.00 to O`ahu Council for each member. The club will also pay the \$40.00 registration fee for each delegate and alternate committing to represent PKHCC at convention. Interesting committee meetings are held where resolutions are presented, discussed and acted upon. We are fortunate to have such a large membership as it allows us many delegates/alternates to speak and vote on our behalf. Our delegates/alternates will caucus prior to convention to discuss the various resolutions and determine the mana`o of the club in preparation for representing our club in committee and 'on the floor' at convention.

All delegates and alternates are asked to attend the next O`ahu Council meeting on September 23 (pre-convention) as there will be an election of the O`ahu Council President and (3) Directors to the AOHCC Board. As a matter of fact, Charles Rose, Nominations Committee Chair is accepting nominations for the following offices for O`ahu Council: President; (3) Association Directors; First VP; Second VP; Treasurer; (4) Council Directors - Information attached.

After you review the convention materials, please respond to me if you plan to attend the convention and represent PKHCC as a delegate or alternate. Please remember that PKHCC will pay the registration fee for members only. If you have a non-member guest attending any of the activities, you will be responsible for paying the convention registration fee for your guest. Payment of any activities should be as noted on the form and payable to the O`ahu Council.

We also encourage all delegates/alternates to attend our General Membership Meeting on October 11th where final Convention and Resolution details will be covered.
